Qualified Coaches	All Coaches working within the Jersey Squash Academy are England Squash qualified coaches, fully insured, have undertaken DBS Checks and have attended Safeguarding and Child Protection courses, as well as First Aid Courses.
Clothing & Equipment	 Suitable sports clothing and shoes with non-marking soles must be worn for all sessions. Rackets & Goggles can be borrowed free of charge. Goggles must be worn at all times when on court. A named refillable drinks bottle must be brought to each session.
Session drop off and collection	We kindly ask that all primary school aged children are dropped off in person by a parent or guardian/responsible adult to the meeting area by courts C and D and similarly collected from the same area by courts C and D. We recognise that some primary school age players may walk to and from Academy sessions. Please notify Antony Harkin email: <u>antony@jerseysquash.org.je</u> if this is the case or you want to make alternative arrangements. For all secondary school age children we expect parents to make pick up and drop off arrangements with their child. Children are always welcome to wait by courts C and D if a parent or guardian is collecting late.

In addition, Jersey Junior Academy players are expected to participate fully in their classes and be respectful to both coaches and fellow players at all times. Unreasonable, disruptive or bullying behaviour will not be tolerated at any Jersey Squash Academy Sessions. If there is an instant of unacceptable behaviour, the individual responsible will receive a warning (and their parents will be notified).
